

The Church Today

General Assembly, the biennial church-wide gathering of the Presbyterian Church (USA), was held online over two weekends in June. Instead of traveling to Baltimore, the 500 commissioners of the 224th GA sat down at their computers for worship and meetings. At least two devices were required to capture live-streaming of events and voting by virtual ballots.

Much may have been lost in the way of informal fellowship and the experience of being together at the convention. But the intimacy of motions made from kitchen tables and home offices, access to behind the scenes production staff and volunteers in Louisville (the church's parliamentarian was a rock star for her handling of heated discussion about motions being drafted in real-time), and the experience of being together in Spirit from all over the world was nonetheless exciting.

The business taken up at the 224th GA reduced due to the sheer size of the technical undertaking. However, concerns relating to racial justice and COVID-19 spilled off the streets and onto the commissioners' screens. These concerns were centered as too important and too immediate to be "rolled over" to the 225th GA in 2022. Among the items that came out of this unique assembly were statements that the church has been both yearning to make and needing to hear: about the state of Native American churches; the disproportionate impact of

COVID-19 on minorities and marginalized groups; and the sin of racism with a call to action.

That call has gone out now to the churches of the PC(USA) and the world awaits our response.

Session Summary

July 2020

Session called the Officer Nominating Committee to begin working on a slate of nominees for the Pastor Nominating Committee. Seven church members (one of whom will be an active elder) and one alternate will be elected by the congregation to search for the next installed pastor of the church.

The Officer Nominating Committee will also be busy calling members to serve as elders and deacons for the class of 2023.

Building and Grounds continues to work on modifications to make the church safe for all. Care Committee assisted members of the congregation as well as the staff and families of Small Blessings and Share the Care with emergency grants. The Sunday school year will kick off on August 23 with some classes meeting online. Outreach is planning online events and new ways to reach the community. Technology made repairs to computers, printers and phones after a lightning strike. Worship is partnering with Christian Education for a proposed Wednesday night program outside. Youth are collecting backpacks for students returning to school and recognized three graduating seniors. A confirmation class is planned for the fall.

Stewardship 2021 is underway with committees working on budgets and a pledge campaign slated for late September.

The church website is being updated for use on tablets and phones.

Session has been developing guidelines for in-person gatherings to resume as it is safe to do so. Online worship and online events and programs will continue to be offered.

Beginning **August 2** - we will be providing nursery, walker/toddler and preschool care in Smith Hall for the 8:30am service.

Children's Church program for Rising K – Rising 5th Graders begins August 2 – 8:30am service! Children will attend worship with their family and after the children's sermon be escorted to Room 15 of Smith Hall for a fun filled time of learning!

To create your KidCheck account, please do so by going to go.kidcheck.com and selecting "Create Your KidCheck Account". Or download the KidCheck Mobile App from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play Store](#) to create, manage, and update your account right on your mobile device.

Create your account from the comfort of home. It's simple and will only take a few minutes. Creating your account prior to the above date helps us have a smooth transition and helps your first check-in go more quickly so you can be on your way.

Once you've created your account, you will simply use your 10 digit phone number to check-in and receive your child's name/security badge.
